On Friday, January 17th there will be a 2-hour early out for students. Mid term reports will go home this day also.

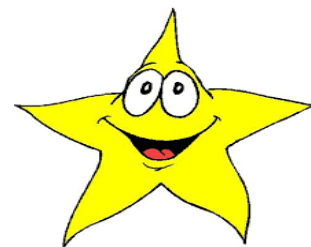
There will be no school on Monday, January 20th in recognition of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.
